October 4th, a very special day: 62 years ago, on this day, Sputnik 1 began the era of active Space Exploration and Astronautics. We have selected Peenemuende (Germany) for the second time in order to commemorate and honor this achievement by starting 62 balloons there as a symbol of hope for a peaceful future.

We also selected Peenemuende for this occasion due to the fact that the development of the first liquid fueled rocket took place there and the first rocket to successfully reach Space.

Would you like to be part in this initiative for peace? Then send your name, your address, and your e-mail address to us. The information you are providing to us will be printed on a small card and attached to one of the 62 balloons. These balloons may stay up in the air for up to 8 hours and may reach different European countries. Persons, who may find the balloon with your card attached, should write a receipt note to your mail address. This way you may receive mail from someone in Europe.

By participating, we will publish your name and mail address on our Internet page, however NOT your e-mail address, unless you give us special permission to do so.

You may also write your personalized "Message of Peace" on our Internet page. In German, English, or Russian. The message should not exceed 400 characters, however.
